You will have an opportunity to talk at length about your child's first term at school at parent teacher interviews later this term. Class newsletters outlining classroom learning and expectations will be sent home this Friday afternoon by all classroom teachers via your child's school bag, so please look out for that.

Our STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) building is nearing full completion with the outdoor learning area being completed at the front of the school as we speak. This new building is a spectacular space and will allow classes to design and carry out some fascinating learning in the area of STEM. Careers involving STEM skills is the fastest growing job market both locally and internationally and is one that is evolving rapidly. Jordan Dickie, our school STEM coordinator will be sending home information in future newsletters about what the students will be learning for STEM. In addition to the new building the year 5/6 and 7 students at Salisbury Park have all been provided with a lap-top between 2 that will be permanently housed in their respective classrooms. They will be used regularly to support a range of learning however we will still have a very tight focus on the explicit teaching of the basics of reading, writing and mathematics along with our specialist subjects. The students in year 5,6 and 7 are working through our Salisbury Park Cyber Safety Agreement which outlines the safe, respectful and efficient use of the new machines. The Cyber Safety agreement will be posted on our school website in due course.

Well done to all of those parents who have returned their forms for Grow Up Smiling (GUS). The FREE mobile dental service that will be visiting our school in two weeks time. If you want to take advantage of this service you need to return the forms to the front office by Wednesday the 14th of February (next week). If you don't then you will have to wait for a return visit much later in the year.
