Greetings everyone,

As usual we have had a great start to term 3 and we are off and running. This Friday all parents will receive a class newsletter outlining the curriculum for term 3. We do this every term in week 2 in an attempt to keep you up to date and informed about your child's learning.

We have introduced Seesaw across the school this year and currently over 4,500 pieces of work have been posted by teachers and 5,468 visits by families to student portfolios. There has been 1,869 comments on student's work and currently 152 families connecting to Seesaw. Salisbury Park Primary is a school that embraces 21st Century learning and we are part of the Seesaw for Schools community. Each year your child's portfolio will move with them which is great news. If you haven't joined our Seesaw community but want to, speak to your child's teacher for details.

I would like to thank our wonderful new Science teacher Mrs Tinney for getting Seesaw up and running across all classes. Mrs Tinney has been a wonderful addition to our teaching staff and has brought a lot of energy and new ideas to the role. In fact on week 4 of this term Mrs Tinney has organised a Science Week afternoon on Wednesday the 15th of August where all students will take part in a range of fun and exciting Science experiments. Mrs Tinney will be taking lots of photographs on the day and many of these will be posted on Seesaw.

Other important dates include our Japanese and Science assembly on the 17th of August and the big one ladies and gentlemen is Book Week. Staff are in the process of reading a range of short-listed children's books to their students and re-enforcing our mantra of 'kids who read succeed' and 'kids who write take flight.' The staff are all very excited about this year's book week theme of 'Find Your Treasure' and we are all in the process of organising our costumes. The staff here love to have fun with the kids and we all dress up for the book week parade on the 24th of August. Make sure you join us for not only the parade but the community breakfast on Wednesday the 22nd of August; the pancakes are amazing. Detailed information will be sent home via the Skoolbag app very soon.

As Principal I would like to thank you for your ongoing support. This is a great community and I feel very privileged to be a part of it.
