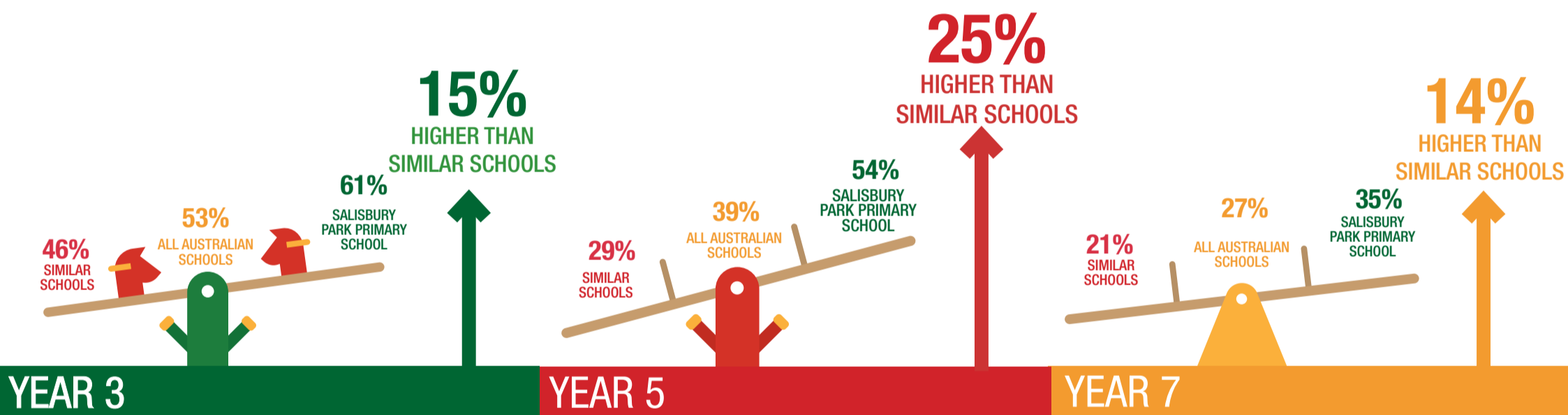
Our 2017 External Review affirmed that we needed to strengthen our moderation processes and design learning tasks that were appropriate for all students. We also needed to consider a whole school approach to develop processes that engage, stretch and challenge students to think critically and creatively.

Since that time we have been working steadily towards achieving these two important priorities. Our 2018 NAPLAN results reveal our outstanding achievements, especially when compared to other schools. As a school we have strengthened the capacity of staff and students and as a result, have seen enormous progress.

Our results are equal to or above the results of **ALL AUSTRALIAN SCHOOLS (PUBLIC & PRIVATE)** in 13 out of the 15 NAPLAN categories.

**Our students have made significant progress in the average student achievement in Numeracy but there's still work to be done!**



The NAPLAN points used above are constructed so that any given score represents the same level of achievement over time. For example, a score of 400 in numeracy will have the same meaning in 2018 as in 2010. This enables changes in achievements by students to be monitored over time.
